In returning them by mail, they must be so wrapped that the contents of the package may be examined at the Post-Office, without having to cut the wrapper or the cord with which it may be tied. If tied with string, a slip-knot, and not a hard knot, should be made. The package must not be pasted or sealed. An envelope notched at the corners is not a proper wrapper. Writing of any kind must not be enclosed in the package, but the name and address of the sender may be written upon the outside. Any violation of these regulations subjects the package to letter postage, which, in many cases, exceeds the value of the goods. When you return goods, always write to us about them on the same day.

When writing to us, be sure to have your name, post-office, county and State written plainly. Full and legible addresses, besides greatly facilitating business, insure prompt attention. Illegible orders and imperfect addresses are necessarily attended to last. After making out your order, it is advisable to look carefully over it, to see whether it is correct. It takes but a moment, and often prevents much after-trouble.
